Yasaka-no-to (pagoda)

This pagoda is formally known as Hoka-ji Temple. Standing at 47 meters high, the current pagoda was built by Yoshinori Ashikaga (1394-1441), the sixth shogun in the Muromachi era.

Kaizando hall

Now an important cultural asset, Kaizando hall was Kitanomandokoro's private worship hall, and exudes the style of the Momoyama era.
