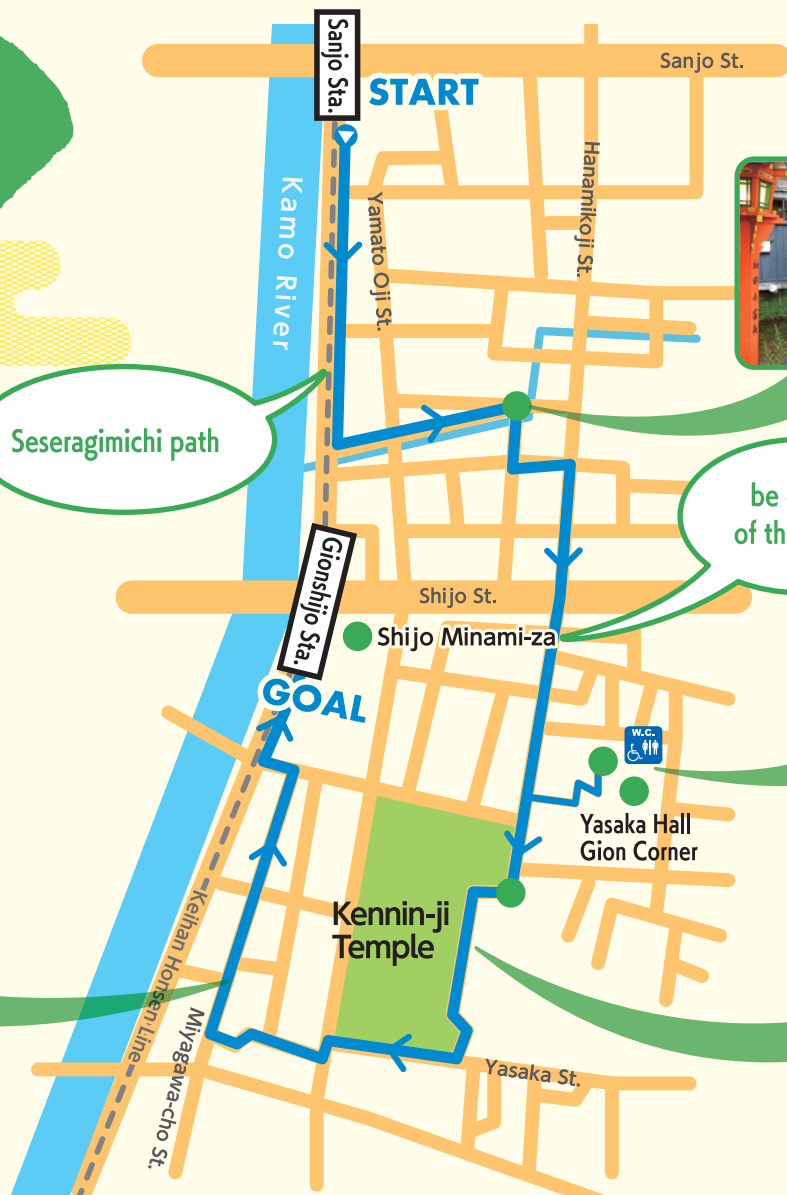


# Geisha encounters
