Nishiki Market

This market has long been known as "Kyoto's kitchen". Each individual shop specializes in certain commodities, such as fish, pickles, tofu, mackerel sushi or Kyoto vegetables. The market passageway is level (no steps/ramped steps) so wheelchair and buggy users can browse the market comfortably.
