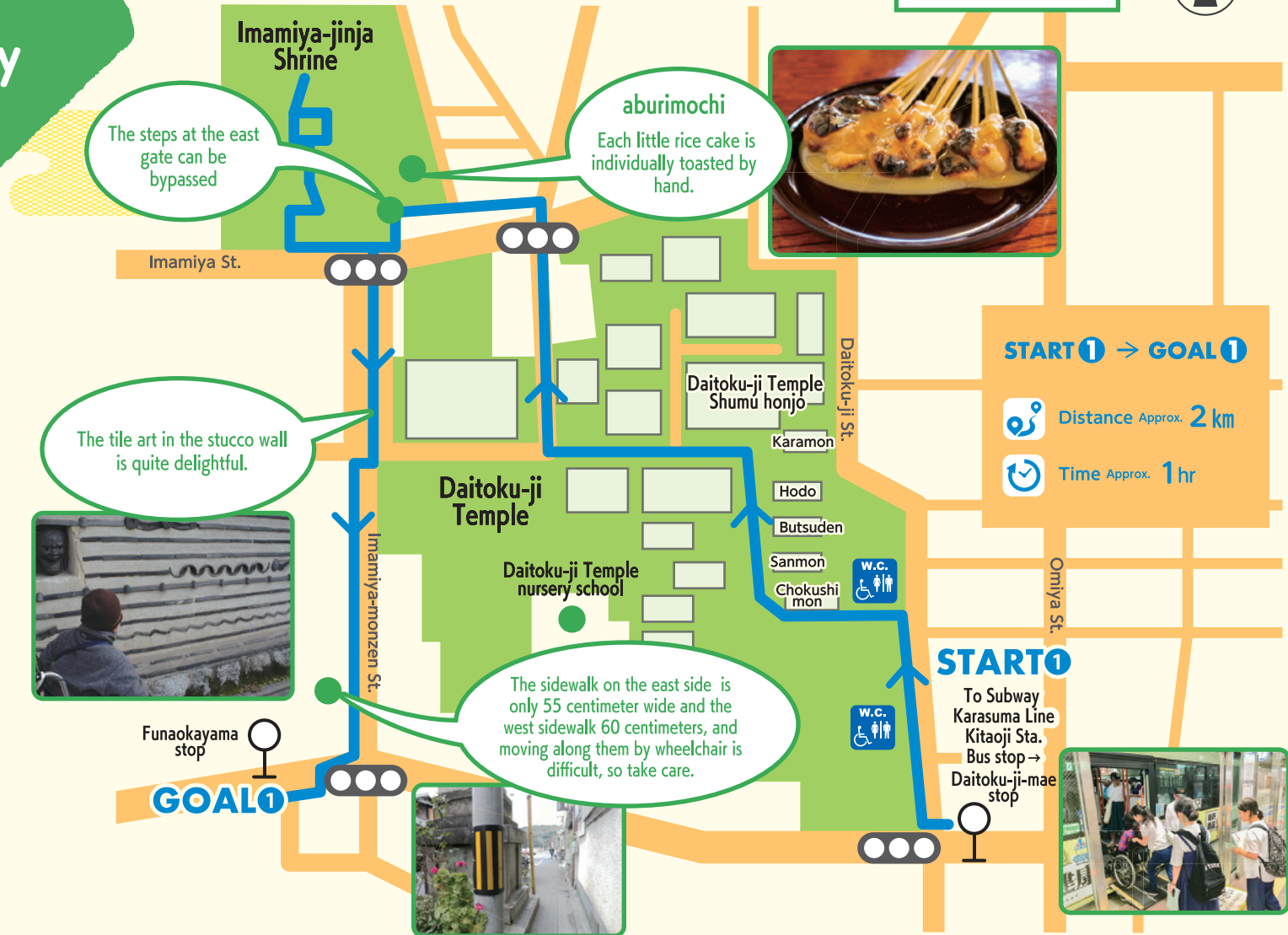
Imamiya-jinja Shrine

This shrine was established to assuage plagues that were prevalent back in the Heian period. There are many steps and gullies in the grounds, so wheelchair users will need assistance.



Daitoku-ji Temple

Daitokuji Temple is one of the five great zen temples in Kyoto. The best known are the small sub-temples Daisen-in and Koto-in. Both have small, beautiful gardens.

Kinkaku-ji Temple

Kinkaku-ji Temple

This temple's formal name is Rokuon-ji, and it was built as a mountain retreat temple for Yoshimitsu Ashikaga, the third shogun to control the Muromachi Shogunate. The golden pavilion (Kinkaku) is a three-tiered structure representative of the Kitayama Culture that combined the cultures of samurais and nobles. The roof is topped with a Chinese firebird. The pavilion burned down in 1950 but was rebuilt in 1955. The temple was registered as a World Heritage Site in 1994.

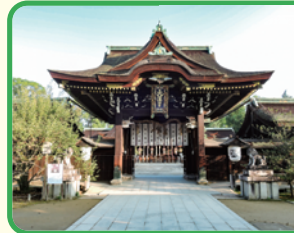
