This is Ryoma-dori, a flagstone shopping street that runs as far as Aburakake-dori, some 70 meters away.

Opened in 1897, the Kyoto National Museum is one of Japan's oldest and most distinguished museums.



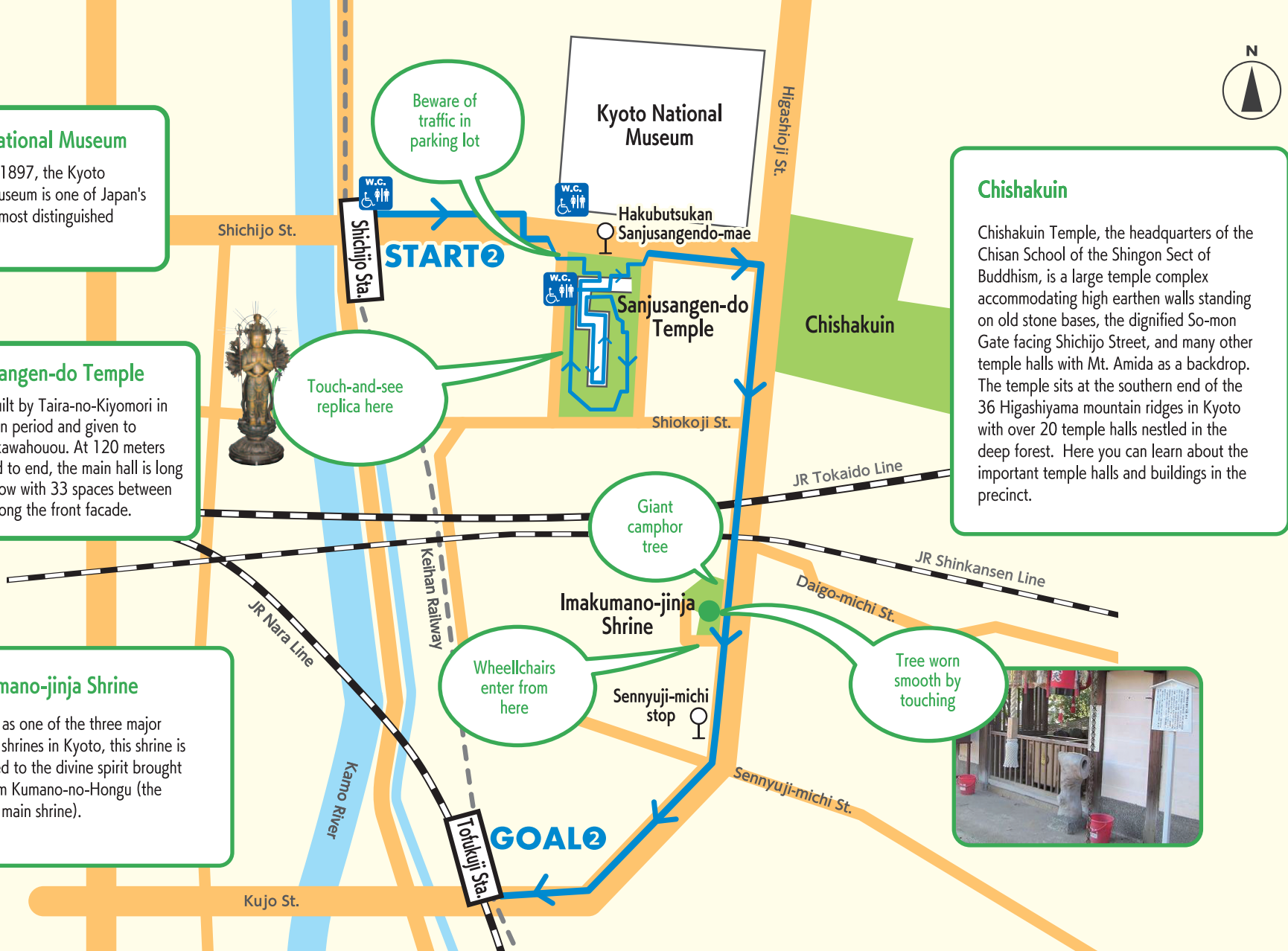
### Sanjusangen-do Temple

It was built by Taira-no-Kiyomori in the Heian period and given to Goshirakawahouou. At 120 meters from end to end, the main hall is long and narrow with 33 spaces between pillars along the front facade.



### Imakumano-jinja Shrine

Revered as one of the three major Kumano shrines in Kyoto, this shrine is dedicated to the divine spirit brought here from Kumano-no-Hongu (the Kumano main shrine).
