## Kyoto Gyoen

This is the public park (1.3 km north to south and 0.7 km east to west) in the heart of the Imperial Palace (Gosho). Back in the Edo period, this residential area full of the villas and homes of court nobles. And, even today, there are remnants of some of those buildings. Many locals come to enjoy the seasons here in amongst the flora and fauna and changing hues. Many of the broad paths through the gardens are surfaced with thick layers of gravel, but on the west side there is now a solid path, which is the best route to take for wheelchair users and people pushing baby buggies. Services available in the gardens include wheelchair friendly toilets, rental wheelchairs, multilingual pamphlets and considerate parking options.
